Subject No. 1: Briefing on the minutes of last meeting

Resolution: The members were briefed about "Minutes of IQAC meeting" dt. 22nd June 2023 and the "action taken report".

Subject No. 2: To review Value Aided Course on Advanced instruments handling and curriculum related feedback in 2022-23.

Resolution: The details noted were that more than 100 students have completed Value Aided Course on Advanced instruments handling and curriculum related feedback in 2022-23, was satisfactory.

Subject No. 3: Review of work related to CO-PO mapping ,"content beyond syllabus" MOOCs -IKS, Guide allotment for B.Pharm. Sem-8 projects.

Resolution: PO attainment scores of graduating batch were noted. Various activities are discussed to support attainment of certain PO. It was resolved that Faculty should to be encouraged to take-up MOOCs related to Indian Knowledge Systems and Guides for Final Year B.Pharm. projects should be allotted in 7th Semester itself.

Subject No. 4: To discuss about In-house project competition and MOU/collaboration with NGO for extension activity.

Resolution: a) To conduct In-house projects competition for the projects completed in 22-23.
b) MOU in process with Harshdeep Foundation and Nayee Udaan NGO should be completed on priority.

Subject No. 5: To review Cleaning activity, Facility feedback by students, training to students on usage of library resources and up gradation of Infrastructure facility

Resolution: It was noted that scores for weekly cleaning monitoring in the first quarter of 2023-24 were in the range of 4.47 to 5.54. This shows improvement over last year.

b)It was noted that most of the facilities provided by the institute were rated more than 50% as very good with few exceptions like the boys and girls common room and canteen was rated needing improvement. c) Currently we are accessing the bandwidth of 100 Mbps speed of internet. Considering the increased in the number of computers and number of students users, the current speed of internet achieving around 70-80 Mbps. It was resolved that we should increase the bandwidth of internet so browsing can be done without facing of any issue in opening of important sites like AICTE, SPPU, UGC, NAAC d)It was noted that User ID based internet connection is being used for safety.

Subject No. 3: Review of the college academic calendar till date.

Resolution: Principal Dr. Ashwini Madgulkar has reviewed the planned activities and presented the following:

- a) The standing committees like CDC, Anti-ragging committee, Anti-discrimination cell. Grievance Redressal Committee have conducted the meetings as per the schedule. The activity by ICC will be planned when contact details of resource person are available from Central media team.
- b) FY orientation and Welcome party were conducted online.
- c) Personality development workshop was conducted for B. Pharm. and M. Pharm. students during 7th to 12th Dec 2020
- d) As per PCI notification, information regarding PCI affiliation has been uploaded at PCI website and necessary fees have been paid in Jan. 2021.
- e) Start-up related talks as well as Alumni interaction sessions have been organized.

Some planned activities could not be conducted since the students are not permitted to physically join college due to pandemic. These are Health Check-up, Animal handling workshop, Sports week and NSS camp.

Subject No. 4: Planning of the development of non-teaching staff in the current academic year 2020-21.

Resolution: The college has received proposal for ONLINE development program. It will be organised with due permission from management.

Subject No. 5: To review "Students' Exit Feedback" and "students placements data for 2019-20"

Resolution: It was noted that Graduate exit feedback was overall a favourable report, appreciating the teaching quality, support of non teaching staff and encouragement and support and guidance for co curricular and extracurricular activities. Contribution of college to personality development was appreciated. Report by post graduate students was favorable appreciating research guidance, research facilities and overall infrastructure. The infrastructure and research environment was appreciated.

Comments for improvement were mentioned for Library, Placement and Industry projects

The concerned committees are working on improvement.

Placement 2019-20: 06 students (01 B Pharm and 05 M Pharm) placed in Sanofi, Goa in Production, packaging and quality control. Joining was delayed because of pandemic and delays in results. All students joined by October 2020. 02 M Pharm students were selected at Emcure pharm., Pune through online interviews. They were placed in Chemistry R and D and In regulatory affairs departments. Students whatsapp groups have been formed separately for B Pharm and M pharm passed out batch and continuously placement opportunities are posted on the groups and logistic support provided to the students. Subject No. 6: To review status of grant applications so far.

Resolution: It was noted that recently AICTE has given call for proposal submission under MODROB. While due to limit in the number of proposal submission, only Dr. M.C. Damle has been able to submit under MODROB scheme and the proposal is under evaluation. Three more proposals are submitted under SERB power by Dr. Ashwini R. Madgulkar, Dr. Damle and Dr. Trupti Chitre and these are under evaluation. There are 5 research proposals (1 DST, 1 DBT and 3 from AICTE) are showing pending to evaluate.

Subject No. 7: To discuss pros-cons of starting new research journal (online)

Resolution: Dr M R Bhalekar reported to IQAC that the basic preparation for starting such a journal as per requirement of NAAC has been done. He also informed that this journal will encompass work done in all related field such as cosmetic, herbal, AYUSH, dental, microbiology.

The members were requested to share their views regarding whether funds, availability of manuscripts . increased work load to staff concerned with this would be deterrent to actually starting the journal. Mrs Nanda Bakhle (parent representative) and Dr Narendra Kadoo also contributed their views. Dr Ashwini Madgulkar provided a detailed picture of difficulties that might confront such a venture.

Subject No. 8: To review extension activities and Guest lectures planned/conducted in 2020-21 Resolution: The reports of Youth Day and Concern Days of Line 11, 1997

Resolution: The reports of Youth Day and Cancer Day celebrated in Jan 2021 and International Women's Day in March 2021 were presented. Summary of guest lectures organised for students and faculty was also noted.

Subject No. 9: To review ELAT scores

Resolution:

It was noted that "Teaching-Learning and Evaluation Committee" conducts Entry Level Aptitude test for newly admitted students on the day of Orientation. It consists of MCQs on Science and English. The scores are communicated to all teachers so that due guidance can be provided during mentoring meetings and regular academics.

Subject No. 10: Result analysis of SPPU exams of Oct. 2020

Resolution: It was noted that more than about 90% students have scored SGPA more than 7 out of 10. A list of students scoring less than 7 is circulated to all teachers so that so guidance for studies can be provided by the concerned subject teachers.

Subject No. 11: Summary of students' feedback on faculty performance

Resolution: The Salient Features of Faculty performance evaluation through Students' feedback were

Conducted online using Google form/sheet from all students of the respective class. The feedback was sought on parameters which were revised especially for online teaching mode.

The scores (out of maximum 5) for teachers were not less than 3, and maximum was 4.1. The feedback summary of the class was provided to each teacher with remarks from the principal.


Detailed Description of Activity Attended:

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY POLICIES FOR FILING AND PROTECTION

INTRODUCTION

Intellectual property rights (IPR) refers to the legal rights given to the inventor or creator to protect his invention or creation for a certain period of time. These legal rights confer an exclusive right to the inventor/creator or his assignee to fully utilize his/her invention/creation for a given period of time. IPRs are essential to fostering innovation to encourage inventiveness in various areas of research and development. It contributes to ensure profitability and better service to the society.

OBJECTIVES

The key objectives of Institute IPR policy is as follows:

- To create awareness about the economic, social and cultural benefits of IPRs to encourage and facilitate the generation of inventions
- To encourage creative and innovative research leading to the generation of new knowledge, ideas and inventions.
- To facilitate the transfer of Institute developed research results and new knowledge to commerce and industry.
- To provide faculty members and students of Institute assistance in assessing the patentability and commercial potential of their inventions.
- To train faculty members and students about provisional patent filing procedures in India as well as the procedure for filing the Applications under the Patent Cooperation Treaty
- To make faculty members and students familiar with Patent filing forms (Form- 1, 2 & 5) and various requirements/data to be provided for filling of such forms:
- To facilitate the filing of applications and licensing where prima facie the IP Cell AISSMS College of Pharmacy, Pune finds it patentable.

MISSION:

To foster creativity and innovation and thereby, promote entrepreneurship and enhance socio-economic development, improve access to healthcare and environmental protection, among other sectors of vital social, economic and technological importance for the benefit of India and society at large.

VISION

To create a culture where creativity and innovation are stimulated by Intellectual Property for the benefit of all for promoting advancement in science and technology, arts and culture, traditional knowledge and biodiversity resources.

GUIDELINES FOR INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY PROTECTION AND ITS LICENSING

- An IPR facilitating cell, an interface between the Institute faculty and the Patent/copyright attorney shall guide and help the faculty and students of Institute in patentability assessment and to apply for patents/ copyright/ trademark applications.
- The Institute faculty desirous of filing a patent or copyright or trademark application would be advised to contact the IP cell regarding these issues.
- An internal approval form (available at IP cell) filled by the PI wherein names of the inventors/authors shall be mentioned, is to be signed by the PI and forwarded to Principal of Institute.
- Invention disclosure description (in invention disclosure format) is to be forwarded along with the duly signed approval form to the IP cell for further action.
- Invention disclosure/ Patent/Copyright/Trademark and similar documents are to be treated as confidential.
- Since patenting is expensive, efforts should be made to get the patent filed through other funding agencies with permission from committee chairperson.
- The IP cell shall help the inventor in drafting of the patent specification / copyright or trademark application and filling of relevant forms.
- The draft application along with the relevant forms shall then be forwarded to a patent attorney present on the panel of Institute.
- The IPR cell shall correspond with the attorney and the inventors on IP matters.
- The committee for approval for patent filing would consist of: Principal(chairperson), Dean Research of the subject, the IP Chair and Finance Officer or his nominee in case where Institute funds need to be utilized.
- The inventors would be required to cooperate with the IP cell to expedite furnishing of information for timely actions since delay would mean payment of extra fee to the patent office and the attorney.
- Any work sought to be filed by a faculty member and or students arising out of R&D work done at the Institute will required to be filed in joint names as inventors or authors while Institute shall be to the owner of IP.
- After filing of the application for IP protection, the inventors shall inform the IPR cell
 of any further development, if any, in the related R&D work.

• The IPR Cell and inventors in collaboration with Research Council shall work together for dissemination of the Intellectual property to public and industry to aid in commercialization.

GENERAL PROCEDURE PATENT FILING

- STEP 1: Check your invention is patentable or not
- STEP 2: Conduct the Patent Search
- STEP 3: If search is clear then preparation of Patent forms and documentation
- STEP 4: Filing of Patent application in proper format with supporting signed documents
- STEP 5: Publication after 18 months
- STEP 6: Pre Grant Opposition /Representation (IF ANY)
- STEP 7: Request for Examination
- STEP 8: First Examination Report
- STEP 9: Publication of Grant of Patent (GRANT OF PATENT)
- STEP 10: Post Grant Opposition to grant of Patent
- STEP 11: Renewing the Patent

- Form 26 Power of Attorney in (in original) (if filed through attorney)
- Form 5 in Declaration of Inventor-ship
- Form 18 (Only in case of an Indian Application for Request for examination
- Requisite Statutory fees (cheque / DD)

ACADEMIC INSTITUTE COLLABORATION

The Collaborative R&D Projects constitute the projects wherein there are two or more agencies are the participants. These projects are partially funded by a private entity (client)and/or supplemented by the university and/or by a Government R&D funding agency. These projects can be for up scaling & validation of lab level know how or for technology development.

To smoothen the process of collaborative R&D with Industry and tech transfer, robust and broad guidelines are required to be formulated by the Institute for:

- Project costing/costing of technology/know-how,
- Permissions required by the PI for collaborative research with industry and techtransfer and authorized signatories for the same,
- Modalities of IP protection and its maintenance,
- Source of the funds required for IP protection and maintenance,
- Modalities of IP protection (whom to approach, authorized department/officer/committee),
- The terms and conditions of MOA for collaborative R&D and authorized signatories,
- Evaluation of technology/know-how.
- Ownership of the patents, if any, generated out of the collaborative research
- Modalities of tech transfer/IP licensing from identification of private partner, negotiations, MoA finalization to finalization of terms and conditions etc.)

A committee must be constituted for approval of Technology Transfer. It may consist of the inventor and IP Cell.

Salient features of the terms and conditions for the collaborative R&D projects to be built up in the Memorandum of Agreement for collaborative R&D.

REVENUE SHARING

The revenue arising out of licensing of IP and royalty would be shared in the ratio [Inventor(s): Institute, 40:60] between the inventor(s) and Institute. The revenue sharing will be subject to agreements between inventor(s) and Institute; where Institute reassigns the right of the IP to its inventor(s), the inventor(s) shall reimburse all the costs incurred by Institute, which include protection, maintenance,marketing and other associated costs and where inventor(s) reassigns the right of the IP to Institute, Institute shall reimburse all the costs incurred by inventor(s), which include protection, maintenance, marketing and other associated costs and where inventor(s), which include protection, maintenance, marketing and other associated costs.

INFRINGEMENTS, DAMAGES, LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY INSURANCE

As a matter of policy, Institute shall, in any contract between the licensee and Institute, seek indemnity from any legal proceedings, including, without limitation manufacturing defects, production problems, design guarantee, up-gradation and debugging obligation. Institute shall also ensure that Institute personnel have an indemnity clause built-into the agreements with licensee(s) while transferring technology or copyrighted material to licensees. Institute shall retain the right to engage or not in any litigation concerning patents and license infringements.

Some planned activities could not be conducted since the students are not permitted to physically join college due to pandemic. These are Health Check-up, Animal handling workshop, Sports week and NSS camp.

Subject No. 4: Planning of the development of non-teaching staff in the current academic year 2020-21.

Resolution: The college has received proposal for ONLINE development program. It will be organised with due permission from management.

Subject No. 5: To review "Students' Exit Feedback" and "students placements data for 2019-20"

All students joined by October 2020. 02 M Pharm students were selected at Emcure pharm., Pune through online interviews. They were placed in Chemistry R and D and In regulatory affairs departments. Students whatsapp groups have been formed separately for B Pharm and M pharm passed out batch and continuously placement opportunities are posted on the groups and logistic support provided to the students. Subject No. 6: To review status of grant applications so far.

Resolution: It was noted that recently AICTE has given call for proposal submission under MODROB. While due to limit in the number of proposal submission, only Dr. M.C. Damle has been able to submit under MODROB scheme and the proposal is under evaluation. Three more proposals are submitted under SERB power by Dr. Ashwini R. 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


