
#### Description of Activity (Details, Attendance, Any other relevant information):







In the guest lecture, speakers have discussed with students regarding the increasing in the rate of cybercrime by using modern telecommunication. They discussed about the offences that

are committed against individuals or groups of individuals with a criminal motive to intentionally harm the reputation of the victim or cause physical or mental harm to the victim directly or indirectly, using modern telecommunication networks such as Internet (Chat rooms, emails, notice boards and groups) and mobile phones (SMS/MMS).

According to them Cybercrime, especially through the Internet, has grown in importance as the computer has become central to commerce, entertainment, and government.

They have conclude the session by giving live examples of the Cyber Crime Investigations under the heads Hacking, Child Pornography, Cyber Stalking, Virus Dissemination, Software Piracy, Credit Card Fraud, Phishing etc.
