HEALTH AWARENESS PROGRAMME

After that, they were sent to their respective doctors where they were appropriately given the right directions regarding their health. The doctors carefully listened to the problems that patients were facing and provided an appropriate solution to cure it. Majority of the people were suffering from chronic joint pain and high/low blood pressure. The camp lasted for four hours, from 10am to 2pm. More than 80 people attended the camp.


