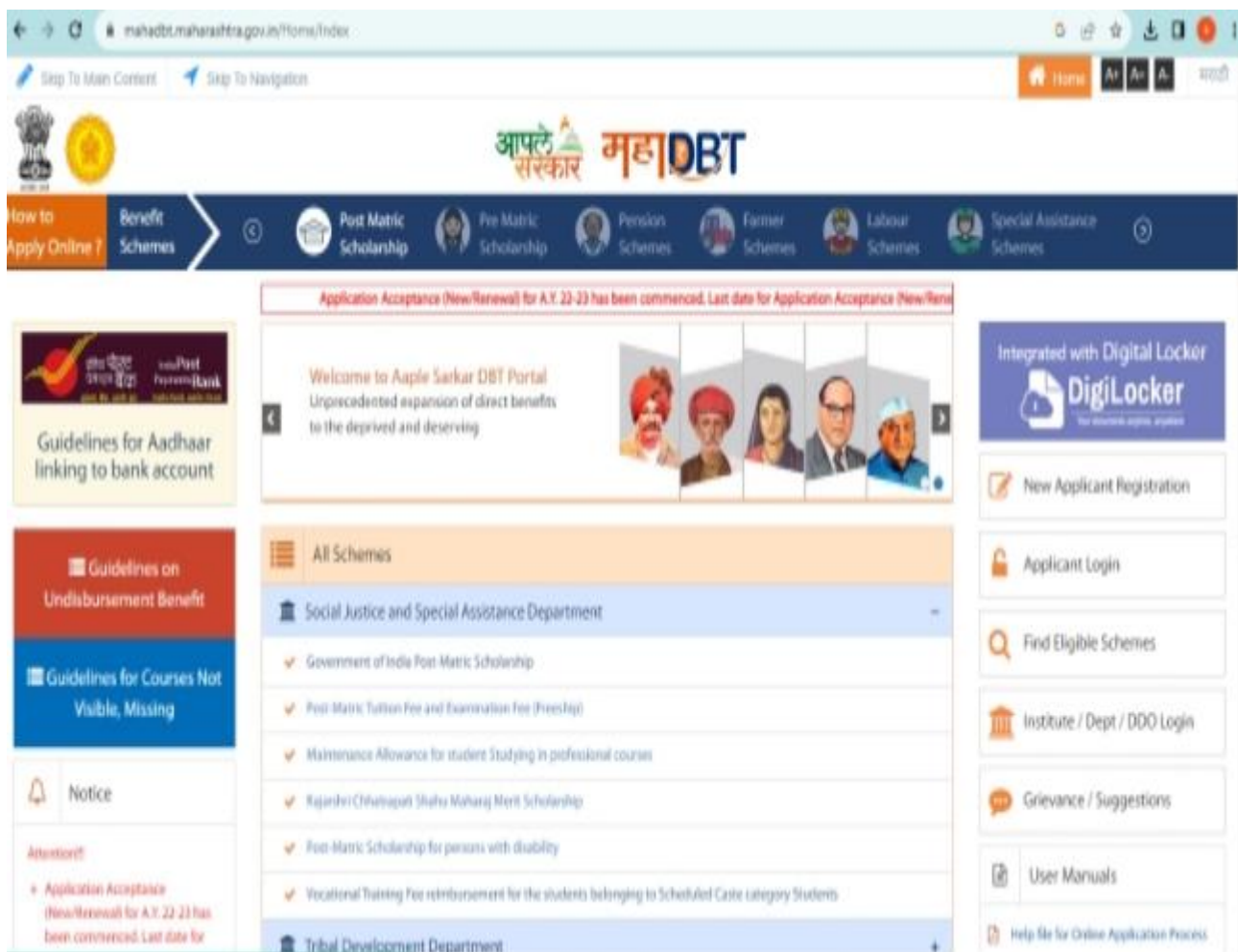

All State governments are hereby advised to ensure the compliance of AICTE scheme on Tuition Fee Waiver as prescribed under point 11 of chapter II of Approval Process Hand Book 2011-12(reproduced below) while admitting to the students in the AICTE approved institutions through competent authority for admission in the state.

11.0			Tuition Fee Waiver scheme (TFW)
	11.1	a	Scheme shall be applicable to all approved technical Institutions offering Bachelor Programs, diploma and Post diploma program of Three/Four years duration
		b	Seats up to maximum 5 percent of sanctioned intake per course shall be available for these admissions. These seats shall be supernumerary in nature.
		c	The Competent Authority for admission shall be the same as for regular admissions.
		d	The scheme shall be mandatory for all Institutions approved by the council.
	11.2		Eligibility
		a	Sons and daughters of parents whose annual income is less than Rs. 2.50 lakhs from all sources shall only be eligible for seats under this scheme
		b	The Waiver is limited to the tuition fee as approved by the State Level Fee committee for self-financing Institutions and by the government for the Government and Government Aided Institutions. All other Fee except tuition fees will have to be paid by the beneficiary.
	11.3		Procedure for Grant of Approval
		a	The Waiver is limited to the tuition fee as approved by the State Level fee Committee for self-financing Institutions and by the Government for the Government and Government Aided Institutions. All other Fee except tuition fees will have to be paid by the beneficiary.

		b	The competent Authority for admission shall be the same as for regular admissions and up to five percent of its sanctioned intake per course shall be available for these admissions. These seats shall be supernumerary in nature.
	11.4		Admissions Procedure
		a	Under this Scheme, up to five percent of sanctioned intake per course shall be available for these admissions. These seats shall be supernumerary in nature.
		b	The competent authority to effect these admissions is the State Government or its designated Authority.
		c	In the event of non-availability of students in this category the same shall not be given to any other category of applications.
		d	State Admission authority shall invite applications under this category, make a separate merit list for this category and effect admissions on the basis of the merit list so generated.
		e	The Institutions shall publish in their brochure and web site the details of this scheme.
		f	Competent Authority for admissions shall submit a separate list of the students admitted under this category to the institute to which they are admitted for compliance.
		g	A letter in this respect shall be issued by the competent authority for admissions to each beneficiary student admitted under this scheme and he/she shall not be allowed to change Institution/course under any circumstances
		h	The Institutions shall also display information regarding admitted candidates in their web sites for information to the students and other stakeholders.

The scheme is mandatory for all AICTE approved institutions, seats up to maximum 5% of sanctioned intake per course shall be made and these seats shall be supernumerary in nature.


ELIGIBILITY


All the regular students admitted in the concerned academic years.





Research Seed Money Policy

1. Introduction

AISSMS College of Pharmacy recognizes the importance of fostering a culture of research and innovation among its staff and students. To encourage and support research projects that contribute to the advancement of pharmaceutical sciences and related fields, the college has established the Research Seed Money Policy. This policy outlines the guidelines and procedures for providing seed money to staff and students for research projects.

2. Objectives

The objectives of the Research Seed Money Policy are as follows:

1. To promote research activities among the staff and students of AISSMS College of Pharmacy.
2. To encourage innovative and high-impact research projects that address current challenges and opportunities in pharmaceutical sciences.
3. To facilitate the generation of preliminary data and proof of concept for grant applications.
4. To enhance the research capabilities and competitiveness of the institution.

3. Eligibility

- a. Staff: Full-time faculty members, researchers, and staff employed by the college are eligible to apply for research seed money. Collaborative projects involving multiple staff members are encouraged.
- b. Students: Undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral students may apply for research seed money under the guidance of a faculty member who will serve as their mentor or principal investigator.

4. Application and Evaluation Process

- a. Application Submission: Applicants are required to submit a research proposal in accordance with the guidelines provided by the Research and Development Committee. The proposal should include a clear description of the research project, its objectives, methodology, expected outcomes, and a detailed budget.
- b. Review and Evaluation: A Committee, appointed by the institution, will evaluate the proposals based on their scientific merit, feasibility, relevance to the field, and potential impact. Each proposal will be scored and ranked by the committee.
- c. Approval: The Research Committee will recommend the allocation of seed money based on the proposal rankings and the available budget. The final approval will be granted by the Honorary Secretary of All India Shri Shivaji Memorial Society.

5. Funding and Duration

- a. Funding Amount: The amount of seed money awarded to each project will depend on the project's scope and requirements, as determined by the Research and Development Committee.
- b. Duration: Seed money projects are typically funded for duration of 6 to 12 months. Extensions may be granted in exceptional cases, subject to a satisfactory progress report.

6. Reporting

Recipients of seed money are required to submit seed money utilization report to the college. These reports should detail the project's advancements, outcomes, challenges faced, and any budgetary adjustments.

7. Intellectual Property Rights

Any intellectual property arising from the research project will be governed by the institution's existing policies on intellectual property rights and research collaboration agreements.

8. Ethical Considerations

All research funded under this policy must adhere to the highest ethical standards, including the use of human and animal subjects, as well as compliance with relevant regulations and ethical guidelines.

9. Disbursement and Accounting


The financial administration and disbursement of seed money funds will be managed by the institution's finance department, following established accounting procedures and compliance with audit requirements.

POLICY DOCUMENT OF NON-GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP

INTRODUCTION:

All India Shri Shivaji Memorial Society's College of Pharmacy promotes students to get scholarships from non-government organisations.

OBJECTIVE:

The aim of the Institute is to spread awareness about scholarships and all needy/eligible students should benefit from it.

PROCEDURE:

1. The institute gives information to first year students and parents about the different types of scholarships opted for by senior students in the orientation programme.
2. If any Brochure or Pamphlet of advertisement is received from private organisations like Lila Poonawalla Foundation, Manjrekar Foundation, HDFC Parivartan Scheme etc., then it is circulated amongst the students.
3. The Students on their own can apply for scholarships. All private organisations who offer scholarships have their own policy to sanction the amount.
4. After sanctioning the Scholarship amount to the eligible students, the amount is given to the College by Cheque or Demand Draft or transferred in the Bank Account of College or students' account. The Students submit the proof of scholarship to the College.
5. If the Scholarship amount of Students is transferred to the College Bank Account, the College gives it to the students by Cheque or transfer to Student's Bank Account. The proof of Scholarship amount transferred to the Student is given to the concerned organization.
