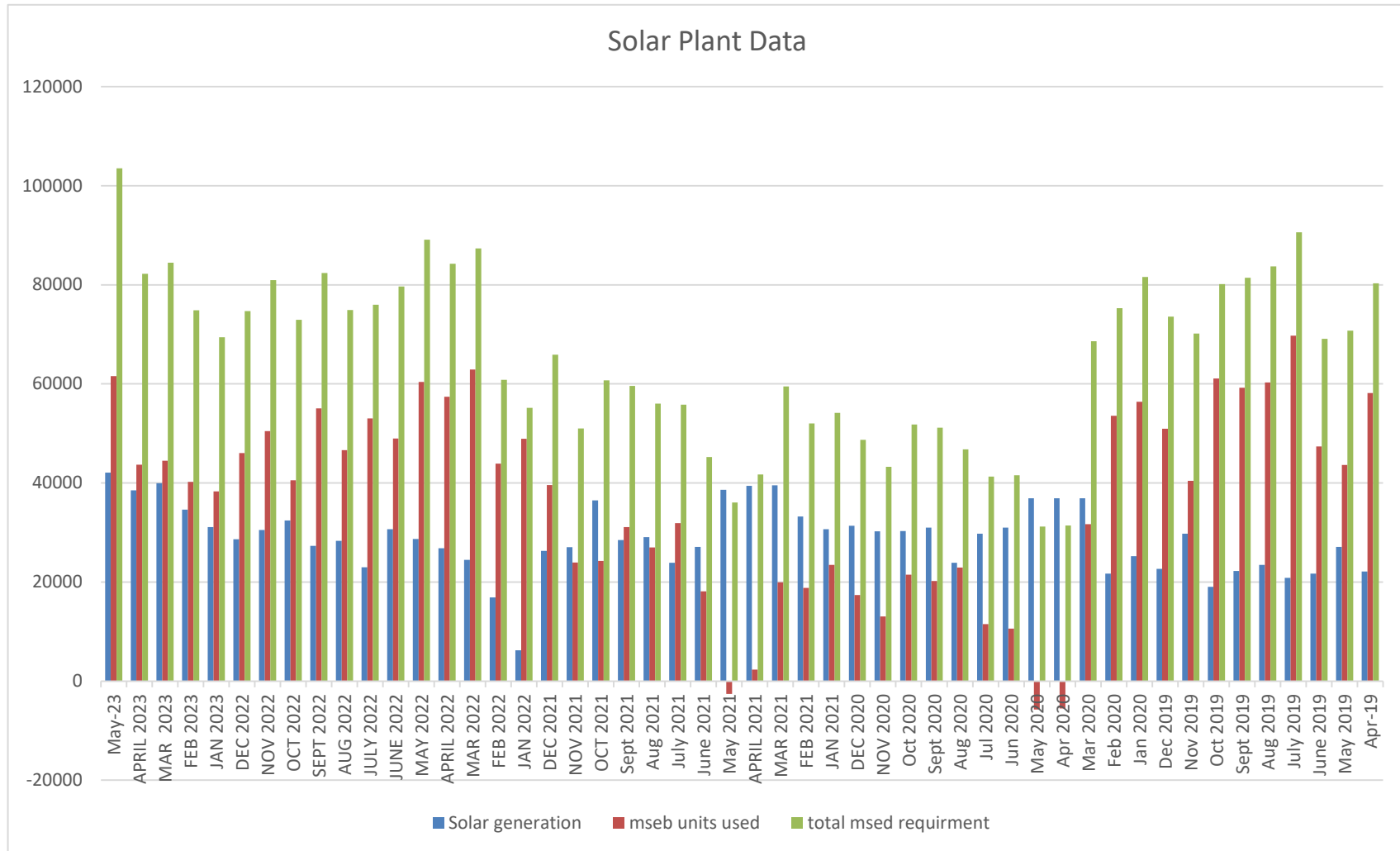

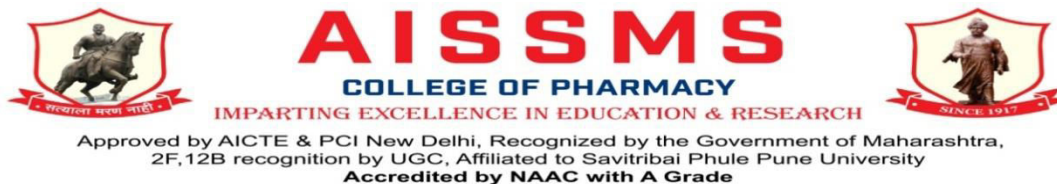

Before Starting

Currently, the annual availability of water is 1123 bcm in India and the demand is around 750 bcm.

However, by 2050 the annual demand for water will be 1180 bcm which will exceed the water availability = wide ramifications for the country.

Nearly half of the country (around 600 million people) face severe water scarcity with around 2 lakh people dying every year due to inadequate access to potable water.

70% of India's water is contaminated. 75% of households do not have drinking water on its premises. 84% of rural households do not have access to piped water.

India's water table is declining in most regions. Also, there is a presence of toxic elements like fluoride, arsenic, mercury, even uranium in our groundwater. Water levels in India's major reservoirs have fallen to 21% of the average of the last decade.

54% of the country's groundwater is declining rapidly than it is being replenished.

Hundreds of small and seasonal rivers are perishing permanently. Almost all the major perennial rivers remain stagnant.

Krishna river runs dry in her delta region for most of the year. According to NITI Aayog's water quality index, India ranks 120th among 122 countries.

Cauvery and its tributaries haven't met the ocean for decades; the upstream dams choke its flows downstream, affecting people in Tamil Nadu.

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Introduction

The Green Campus, Energy and Environment Policies will develop exciting new co-curricular and extracurricular practices that encourage students to take the lead in creating positive change. These initiatives call for a thorough review of all infrastructural, administrative functions from the standpoints of energy efficiency, sustainability and the environment

Objectives of the Policy

- To protect and conserve ecological systems and resources within the campus.
- To ensure judicious use of environmental resources to meet the needs and aspirations of the present and future generations.
- To integrate environmental concerns into policies, plans and programmes for social development and outreach activities.
- To work with all stakeholders and the local community to raise awareness and seek the adoption of environmental good practice and the reduction of any adverse effects on the environment.
- To continuously improve our contribution to climate protection and adaptation to climate change and to the conservation of global resources.
- To continuously improve the efficient use of all resources, including energy and water, and to reduce consumption and the amount of waste produced, recovering and recycling waste where possible.
- To make the campus plastic (nondegradabe) free.

Guidelines for Water, Energy and Environment Conservation and Waste Management:

- **Timely energy, environmental and green audit**

These audits should be carried out from time to and time and necessary corrective measures should be taken
- **Limited entry of vehicles**

The entry of vehicles in the campus is limited.

Further, all the college staff/ faculty/students members are encouraged to use public transport and get a emission certification of their vehicle on timely basis.
- **Use of Bicycle/ battery powered vehicles is encouraged**

The employees and students are encouraged to use public transport or car pool etc. to limit the emissions. Further, use of bicycle or battery powered vehicles is encouraged.

To observe yearly 'No Vehicle Day' to increase awareness.
- **Pedestrian-friendly pathways**

The institute has pedestrian friendly pathways to protect ecological systems
- **Landscaping with trees and plants**

Plant more trees within and outside campus to clean the atmosphere and keep it green. Waste has to be handled at the place of origin. Keep the premises neat and tidy. Commit to manage waste and maintain clean campus especially during college events.
- **Measures for energy conservation**

All should ensure optimum utilization of lights, fans and other electronic devices, turning them off when not in use. The activation of power management systems (power saving modes) in electronic devices like computers, laptops etc. should be done, when not in use. Utilization of LED or compact fluorescent bulbs should be done as far as possible. The purchase of equipments or instruments should be made in view of energy conservation Utilization of alternative sources of energy should be promoted.
- **Digital Library / E-Learning Centre**

All should promote utilization of e-resources like e-books, online journals and soft copies over hard copies/papers wherever possible. All should use e-mail/ messaging services for official communications instead of paper as far as possible. Utilization of learning management systems and e- platforms should be promoted.

➤ **e-Governance**

To minimize the use of paper in administration through promoting E-governance printing of documents should be done back to back whenever feasible to avoid use of more papers.

➤ **Waste Management**

All should aptly utilise the dust bins for waste disposal made available at different locations in premises and the campus. All should strictly exercise separate disposal of dry, wet, electronic and biomedical waste. The disposal of chemicals and laboratory waste should be done suitably by dilution/chemical treatment method. Collaboration with e-waste recycling companies to get electronic waste recycled. E-waste has to be handled properly and disposed off as per norms. Awareness amongst students about reduction of e-waste and environment friendly disposal practices for e-waste.

➤ **Water management**

All are required to use water cautiously. Suitable measures may be taken to prevent wastage of water in conduct of experiments and other day to day activities. Measures for conservation of water like water recycling, rain water harvesting systems etc. should be promoted. While developing a new infrastructure, careful planning should be done with regards to this green and environmental policy.

➤ **Awareness**

Systematically engage with the 3Rs of environment friendliness (Reduce, Reuse and Recycle). Collect paper waste produced on campus and collaborate with scrap dealers for recycling. Based on the environment themes organize programmes and festivals in the campus. New students will be informed about environmental imperatives and related College responsibilities and policies during pre-enrollment orientation. All should strictly adhere to the above mentioned rules and regulations.

Guidelines for Ban on Single Use Plastic in College Premises:

Introduction

Plastic pollution is currently one of the biggest environmental concerns. The short-term benefits and convenience of plastic and plastic goods have led to a boom in the production and consumption of plastic. Over the past century, excess-consumption of plastic has surpassed management of plastic waste and led it to become a scourge to the planet. Plastic is a menace that impacts not only the environment but also our health and wellbeing. We have all contributed to this problem, knowingly and unknowingly and we must work to reduce and eliminate plastic pollution.

Government has decided to take plastic ban as a national level campaign to address the environmental hazards being caused by the indiscriminate use of plastic. Educational institutions must lead this nation-wide endeavour. There is a need for educational institutions to actively contribute to the effort of banning the use of single use plastics.

- Ban on Single-use plastic packing materials in Canteen & stores.
- Identification & implementation of replacements for alternative food and beverages that are sold in canteen which comes in plastic packaging
- Ban on Single-use plastic bottles of 1 litre or less in volume for in-house meetings and events
- Reduction in usage of Single-use plastic banners
- Segregation of Non-Biodegradable plastics by House Keeping staff & safe disposal of the same through authorized agencies.
- Ban on use of plastic materials used for decorations at the events.

Implementation and Compliance


- The college will deploy a team of GREEN WARRIORS for the mission comprising faculty and student advisors who will ensure the Planning and implementation of this Phase-wise Plastic banning in the campus.
- They will thoroughly monitor the implementation of the ban and meet frequently to assess & discuss the extend of ban.
- They also prepare the agenda for next phase of ban implementation.

- All departments inside the campus are responsible for organizing or hosting events and activities in college premises are responsible for ensuring compliance with the policy.
- College management is responsible for ensuring that the necessary facilities and procedures are in place to enable implementation of the policy, with support from the Purchase Committee, Committee on Catering and others.
- The Committee will be responsible for ensuring that restricted items are not sold or distributed in catering outlets, vending machines, or retail outlets on campus.
- The Committee will also be responsible for ensuring that catering and retail outlets will use eco-friendly materials for their packing or serving of food & beverages.

Awareness & Campaigns:

The Green Warriors will also carry out awareness drives and sensitising workshops on the harmful impacts of single use plastics among the Students and Staff to encourage following

- Every student will strive to make his/her household plastic free.
- Students to be incentivised to carry out similar campaigns at community level
- Installation of necessary alternative facilities like water units to avoid the purchase and use of plastic water bottles.
- Ensure presence of alternative solutions like cloth bags etc., to plastic bottles, covers another goods on campuses.
- Conducting events and poster competitions etc. on designing ecological and environment friendly goods to minimise the use of single use plastic

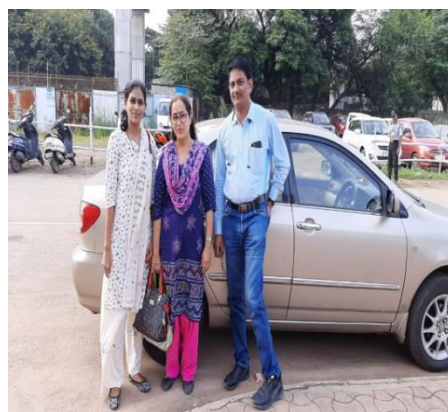



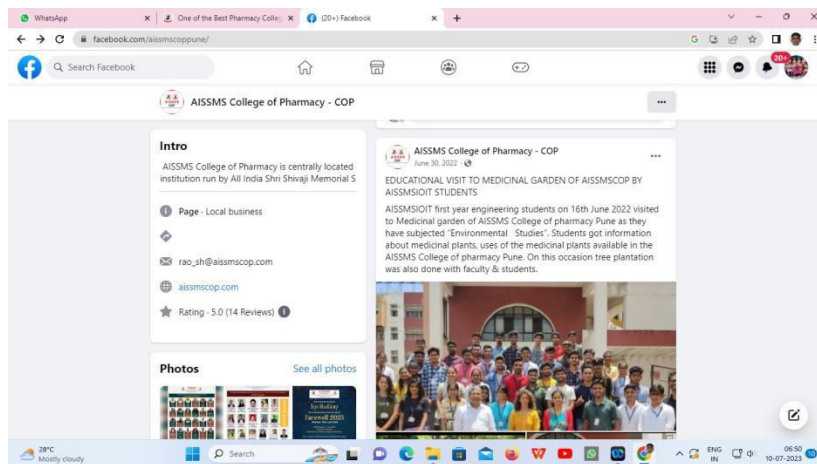

Bird friendly campus and tree plantation programme was conducted in AISSMS College of Pharmacy as a celebration of the world earth day on 22 April 2022.



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
NO VEHICLE DAY 25/09/ 2019


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Ramnadi Restoration Mission workshop - 04/07/19

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KVIFF 2019 Lecture on Plastic Waste recycling 7th Jan.2019



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7.1.2.5: DIFFERENTLY ABLED (DIVYANGJAN) FRIENDLINESS

POLICY DOCUMENT FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (*Divyangjan*)


The Government of India formulated the national policy for persons with disabilities in February 2006 which deals with educational rehabilitation of persons with disabilities, therefore in view of this AISSMS College of Pharmacy has implemented these policies. The AISSMS College of Pharmacy policy recognizes that persons with disabilities are valuable human resource for the institution and seeks to create an environment that provides equal opportunities, protection of their rights and full participation in the academic environment.

Non-Discrimination Policy

AISSMS College of Pharmacy, Pune prohibits discrimination on the basis of disability in regard to application, acceptance, grading, advancement, training, discipline, graduation, or any other aspect related to a student's participation in a program of AISSMS College of Pharmacy. This applies to all students and applicants for admission to the AISSMS college of Pharmacy.

The focus of the policy is on the following:

1. To ensure that the design of the building such as ramp/ lift should be according to the disabled persons.
2. To ensure the accessible, gender-sensitive, safe, usable and functional washroom facilities should be provided for disabled persons.
3. To ensure the proper text and pictogram signage such as tactile path, lights, display boards, signposts are displayed at necessary places.
4. The use of signage of male and female symbols, in accordance with local customs and standards, with raised outlines and bright color contrast will be more evident to everyone and particularly helpful for persons with visual impairments.
5. Learners with disabilities need to be adequately and appropriately supported in and out of the classroom with the right resources and assistive technology, and with leadership, teaching staff and college communities that are responsive to their needs.
6. To ensure the accessibility of software tools and technology for the people with disabilities, if required
7. Provision for enquiry and information: Human assistance, reader, scribe, soft copies of reading material, screen reading are available on request



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
